August 6-28 Gallery One Visual Arts Center of Ellensburg will host a juried art exhibit.

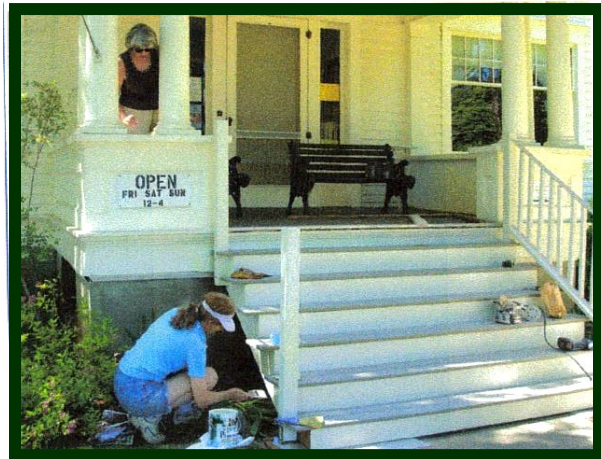
